MSBL WS Manager Profile - Spotlight On Ron Lovell - So Cal MSBL

Ron Lovell is one of the original members of the Southern California MSBL, which began in 1988. Ron is 58 years 'young' and has been playing with a variation of the Angels all of those years and has managed 25 of their 28 years of existence. He has also been playing in the MSBL World Series since the very first one in 1988 and hasn't missed a single one. Not one. Ron is the Lou Gehrig or the Cal Ripken of the So Cal MSBL.



In part because of this amazing achievement, MSBL Founder and President Steve Sigler has honored Ron into the 2015 class of the MSBL World Series Hall of Fame.

"This award means a lot to me because it acknowledges that I have done this for a long time and also done a few good things," said Ron. "It's great to be noticed and the feedback from the local guys has been overwhelming. Thanks, Steve." Ron is primarily managing these days but fills in now and again on the mound and at first base. You'll see him managing the So Cal Fire in the 50's and helping out with the 60 and over entry this year.

"We won a ring in 1995 with the Angels and then again in 2005," explained Lovell. "Then we won a couple in 2009 and 2010 with the So Cal Fire. We've been very fortunate to have some good

teams from here and also stocked with some great people." Ron explained that his biggest World Series thrill came with the acquisition of the first ring. "I was co-manager with Dennis Swartout in 1995 with the Angels and we were in a really tough championship game and won it 4-3," said Ron. "That remains my biggest thrill."

Ron has seen a lot of duty on the hill in Arizona while pitching but arm problems have pretty much sidelined him. "I hurt my elbow five years ago and the doctors told me to rest it and take it easy," added Lovell. "I did as they said but the next year I hurt it again and needed Tommy John surgery and just couldn't recover from it, but I love staying in the game by managing and occasionally playing first base."

Ron is one of the few people who have thrown their hat into the MSBL ring from day one and he is very grateful for the opportunity to keep playing a kid's game. "I want to thank Steve Sigler for putting MSBL together and also thank all of my past and future teammates," said Ron. It's been a Godsend for me. There's no place I'd rather be than on the ball field."
