Temperatures Soar With A Ninth Day of High 90's - 100 For Today! By Tom Prendergast

The theme of most of these newsletter front page articles so far this year has been the way we were and how we got here. Yesterday the 55+ Central and Cactus managers received the news that the minimum requirements of batting at least 14 players in a game was being waived, at least for the playoffs. When we started adding additional divisions (National & American had become incredibly competitive in just a few short years) it quickly became clear that some kind of assurance to the players in this division was necessary and so Steve and his staff came up with a minimum of one plate appearance for a minimum of 15 batters, which was later dropped to 14. For the most part this requirement has been successful and helpful to manager and players alike. However in year 29, it's time to tweak this rule just a little and drop the requirement for the playoffs. The main reason for this change is to limit protest's and settle games on the field. And speaking of protests, the wrong courtesy runner, shared position and A/B batter are all non-protest able. In the event this happens during a game, just call time and fix it. Notify the home plate ump that you think the wrong player is on the field. Let's keep the game simple and enjoyable for all participants.
